Gilbane, one of the country's preeminent construction management businesses, will provide an opportunity for deserving minority students to participate in a paid internship with the Gilbane's New Jersey area offices.

The engineering interns will be eligible to receive a scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 after their successful completion of their assignment. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students will be selected for the program on a competitive basis. Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- * be sophomore or junior at UNCF member institutions, Fairleigh Dickinson University, Pratt Institute, Stevens Institute of Technology and The Cooper Union for the Advancement of Science and Art.
- * be enrolled as major in the field of architecture, civil, electrical or mechanical engineering, construction engineering technology and construction management.
- * be a resident within the Northern New Jersey Region or New York Metropolitan Area.
- * have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above.
- * be willing to participate in an internship position with Gilbane.

THE APPLICATION

The application must be typed and include:

- * Two nominating letters from members of the faculty that details the student's talents, interests, and aspirations;
- * A 500-word double-spaced typed essay on "Yourself and Your Career Goals";
- * An official undergraduate school transcript(s);
- * Resume;
- * Small head-shot photograph of applicant.

SELECTION PROCESS

The UNCF will conduct a preliminary screening of all applicants. Semi-Finalists will be forwarded to Gilbane for review and final selection of award winners.

Each internship will be coordinated under the supervision of a Gilbane employee who will serve as a mentor. Gilbane will select the mentor based on the interest and background of the applicant.
